





STEP 4: Click the magnifying glass in the top left corner to search for a book.

Libby offers both audiobooks and eBooks. You can filter the searches depending on what you're looking for by selecting the "refine" button on the left.



STEP 5: Select the "borrow" button on the book you would like to take out.

If the button states "place a hold," that means that all available copies have been taken out. If selected, the application will notify you when one becomes available.
